Robert Douglas Brock (69) of Clinton, Maryland

Bob Brock died in Clinton, MD on Sunday, February 13th at the age of 69.

In death, Bob joins his son Jason Matthew, his mother Charlotte Frances (nee Hoffman) and his father Robert Everett. He is grieved by his wife Kim (nee Clark); his sons Curtis Russell and Robert Cameron, his daughters-in-law Elizabeth and Jocelyn, his four grandchildren and a vast community that he has touched and inspired.

Born in 1952 in Texas, Bob grew up in Buffalo, New York and served in the Air Force. Stationed in Thailand during the Vietnam War, Bob fell in love with radio and broadcasting, which would later lead to a meeting between a disc jockey and a listener in Florida in 1978—and 43 years of marriage. As a paramedic and volunteer firefighter for more than four decades, Bob served dozens of communities through his life—as he also did through his church congregations and his dedication to serving man.

A loving father and husband and a talented musician, photographer, and engineer; Bob was an avid motorcycle enthusiast and passionate supporter of the local music community.

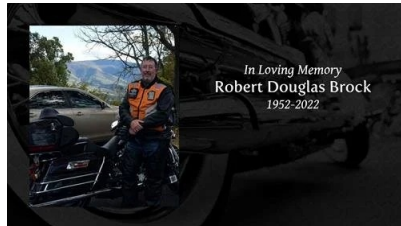
