Minister Walter Everton Edwards, 64, of Trinidad and Tobago departed this life Wednesday, May 18, 2022, at his family home due to Pick's Disease (A Form of Dementia).

Born in Scarborough, Tobago, May 2, 1958, to James Paxton Edwards and Eurena Zetty Bush. In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by his sisters, Alberta and Alma Edwards.

He leaves to mourn his wife, Elizabeth Edwards; his children; Jason, Julien, Curtis, Morissa, Kimberly, Joshua, and Jonah; and several grandchildren. He is survived by seven brothers and four sisters. Also surviving are a host of nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles and many other relatives and friends.
